- Ensure the sustainable practices are generic to good design rather than to specific projects






Figure 1: Range of possible starting points for education in *Design for Sustainability* (after: Dewberry & Fletcher, 2001)

How can we ensure that aesthetics and innovation are maintained equally in sustainable textile design thinking?

How can we attract external funding to support this kind of initiative?









## Aim

How to reduce the many kinds of waste created within the textiles industry, both pre and post consumer?

### Action

Assess the potential forward impact of design choices/decisions, on production use and eventual disposal of textile products. Create a design narrative in response to a life-cycle analysis of the product.

## Example

Slow design; design for long-life and shortlife applications; design with enhanced aesthetic value; zero waste cutting.

















Political Strategists must recognize and promote the power of design innovation to improve our environmental health. Our economic prosperity and social equity depend on it. And you.


#### Society
